

# Understanding Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)

#### What is EPR?

• Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) is a new UK rule that makes businesses responsible for the packaging they put on the market. That means you're not only responsible for supplying products, but also for what happens to the packaging afterwards — whether it's recycled, reused, or disposed of.

The goal: reduce waste, increase recycling, and encourage better packaging design.

# Does EPR apply to you?

You may need to take action if you:

- Sell packaged goods in the UK under your brand
- Import packaging into the UK
- Use packaging to supply products directly to customers or end-users

If any of these apply, you'll have EPR responsibilities. Don't worry – we'll guide you through it.

## What will you need to do?

To comply with EPR, most businesses will need to:

Collect data Track the types and amounts of packaging you use (e.g. paper, plastic, cardboard).



#### Report

Share this data with a compliance scheme or the regulator.

Pay fees Contribute to the cost of collecting and recycling packaging. Fees depend on the material type, weight, and how easy it is to recycle.

Choose smarter packaging Packaging that's lighter, recyclable, or made from recycled material can reduce both your costs and environmental impact.
